## How to use IEEE PDF eXpress®

### 1) Before Creating a PDF

- ☑ Verify that your submission is 2 pages according to the Author's Guide. Any other page length will be grounds for automatic withdrawal.
- ☑ Verify that the margins in your paper are sufficient according to the Author's Guide.
- ☑ Check that the font size of the main text in your paper is no less than 10pt and that your paper meets all other font size specifications in the authors guide.
- ☑ Confirm the Pre-publication Policy for the Symposium.
- ☑ Be aware that if your paper is published prior to the Symposium, it will be withdrawn from the Symposium.
- ☑ Make sure you get approval of your affiliation to submit and present your paper at the Symposium.

### 2) Creating your PDF eXpress Account

Log in to the [IEEE PDF eXpress site](#)

#### **First-time users should do the following:**

1. Select the New Users - Click Here link.
2. Enter the following:
  - **Conference ID: 57934X**
  - Your email address
  - A password
3. Continue to enter information as prompted.

An Online confirmation will be displayed, and an email confirmation will be sent verifying your account setup.


#### **Previous users**

Previous users of PDF eXpress or IEEE PDF eXpress need to follow the above steps, but should enter the same password that was used for previous conferences. Verify that your contact information is valid.
