STEP 1 - AUTHOR LIST:

Author Name:


- Use proper capitalization
- ☐ Use **full** first name, do not use initials.
- DO NOT use all caps.
 - Example: First Name: John Last Name: Smith


Affiliation

- Use the drop-down field to enter the affiliation, be sure to review guidelines below. If affiliation is not in the drop-down you can enter the correct affiliation in this same field.
 - Enter the proper name of the company or institution, no abbreviations
 - DO NOT enter any departments, city, state, country or zip.
 - Use proper capitalization

Example:

- Affiliation: University of California (NOT Univ. of CA)
- Department: Berkeley, Department of Materials Science and Engineering (MSE)






Confirm author order. The order of the authors in the author list view is the way the authors will be listed for the online listing. Presenting Author will always be listed first. Author order should match the pdf paper list, with the possible exception of the presenting author. Do NOT select Finished Adding Authors until you have confirmed all information is correct! No changes to the author list will be permitted after the submission deadline.

PDF PAPER – If accepted, paper will be published as submitted, no changes will be permitted.

- Must use the <u>VLSI paper template</u> to ensure your submission meets the requirements. Click here to download the VLSI A4 paper template.
- Confirm all author names are accounted for and correct
- ☐ Confirm any funding acknowledgement is listed
- ☐ Confirm there are no typos in the author list, title or elsewhere, including diagrams, etc.

Paper ID: 2

- All author information will be published as entered by the submitter
- Paper has been processed through PDF Xpress and compliance number is provided. Papers that are submitted without PDF Xpress compliance may not appear correctly when posted to IEEE eXplore. This could include missing figures, characters and details.




To ensure your paper is published accurately in IEEE Xplore, use IEEE PDF eXpress to check and convert your paper to an IEEE Xplore-compatible PDF. This tool verifies that your PDF meets specific requirements, including PDF version, font embedding, and the absence of certain elements. Make sure to follow these requirements on how to use IEEE PDF eXpress:

- The PDF is version 1.4 (Acrobat 5) or later, but not Acrobat 9, X, or XI.
- The PDF was created with PDF distiller. Scanning is not permitted.
- All fonts are embedded or subset. This ensures that mathematics appear as intended and that text is searchable.
- No password or other security settings are included.
- No bookmarks or links are included.
- There are no crop marks, registration marks, date stamps, timestamps, or any other mark that does not appear in the official version of the paper.
- There are no PostScript settings that can override the settings file.
- No PDF attachments are included.
- The file is not a PDF Package or Merged PDF

STEP 3 - PAPER DETAILS:

- Student authors who are also presenting may request travel assistance. This must be done at time of submission.
 Select the category that best fits your paper (Technology or Circuits), note that the reviewing committee may choose to move your paper to another category as applicable.
 Select the track/topic that best fits your paper, note that the reviewing committee may choose to move your paper to another track as applicable.
- ☐ The abstract summary is typically the 150-word description from your pdf paper and will be the paper description included in the online platform.
- ☐ Use the "View Symbol" button to insert any symbols in your paper title or abstract/short description.
- ☐ If you make any changes to your pdf after submitting it to PDF Xpress, you must process the revised paper through PDF Xpress and provide the new compliant number.
- ☐ If you wish to be considered for a demo session, you must choose Yes and supply a short description. More information above the fields on the website.



STEP 4 - SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

All authors are required to agree to the following requirements. By submitting a paper you confirm you will meet these requirements.

- You understand and agree that the pdf paper attached to this submission is the final paper and no changes to the author list, title, figures or other content can be modified after acceptance.
- VLSI will be held in-person with OnDemand access available after the conference. By submitting your paper, you
 agree to present the paper in-person AND pre-record a video of your presentation to be available for the
 OnDemand portion of the conference.
- You Agree to <u>Submission & Pre-Publication Guidelines</u> (not to pre-publish)
- You have read and agree to the MIRA General Data Protection Regulation Policy
- You have explicit permission to add other authors to your submissions.
- You have reviewed and acknowledge the relevant IEEE privacy policies linked here.
- VLSI fully supports initiatives to make information more engaging and accessible by using inclusive language to
 replace terminology that may be offensive or disrespectful to others. This extends to test images and media data
 used. For example, a head crop picture of Lena Soderberg which was printed in the magazine Playboy has been
 used as a test picture in image processing papers. The use of this image is discouraged as there are many other
 reference images available.


- Paper meets 3 page format. If not, paper will be automatically rejected.
